

What is it?

- A set of 'core' NHS online resources that can be access through OpenAthens login
- Includes journals, databases, and now also includes **e-Learning for Healthcare!**

Who is it for?

- Any HE institutional library with healthcare students can become an ‘administrator’
- Once set up you can enrol students who are on a healthcare course which involves ‘practice and placement within NHS provider services’
- This can be trainee nurses, midwives, doctors, physiotherapists, paramedics...

Why should I bother? Won't their placement do this?

- If students wait for placement then they *may* get a local account

HOWEVER

- Local accounts are only for the length of placement and will be disabled afterwards
- A HEI account stays with them for the duration
- It builds relationships with our NHS colleagues
